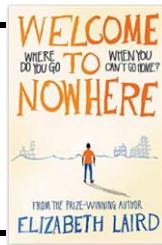

- We will also learn about internet safety.



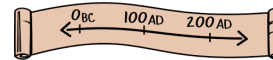
### Science
