grateful.



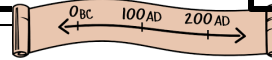
Science

In science we will ask the Big Question: What has

History

In history we will ask the Big Question: What happened
during world war 2? We will look at key events during
the war as well as who the Allies and Axis powers
were. We will also look at the Blitz, air raid shelters,
evacuees, rationing and the experience of soldiers.



Geography

In geography we will ask the Big Question:
What are the effects of acid rain on Germany's
Black Forest? We will learn about fossil fuels
and how they impact the environment.



Music

In music we will study war
time music and create our
own songs. We will use
Vera Lynn and her song
We will meet again.



Art/DT

In art we will look at the
work of the artist Lowry
and create World War 2
paintings. In D&T we will
make and strengthen a
parachute.



Languages

We will be learning about
World War 2 in
French, looking at
adjectives and verbs.



Computing

In computing we will learn
about photography. We
will take selfies and create
self portraits.



PE
