PE Kits

Writing

During this half term, we will be retelling the story of the Stone Age Boy and writing a persuasive script for an advertisement based upon the story of Ug. behaviour



Maths

In maths we will be identifying money, adding and subtracting money, how to tell the time on analogue and digital clocks, identify years, months and days and solve problems with time. We shall also learn how to calculate the perimeter of shapes.



PSHE and RHE

In PSHE, we are focusing upon the skills needed to work effectively as a member of a team. We shall also learn about challenging ourselves and keeping ourselves healthy.



Science

In science, we will be learning about how to identify different types of rocks and their properties as well as learn about the different layers of the Earth.



History

This half term we be applying our historical skills to learn about the Stone Age. We will use the chronology skill to order the Stone Age timeline. We will use the comparison skills to compare Stone Age tools with modern day tools.



Geography

Music

In music, we will be learning how to make sounds with natural objects and our bodies.



Art/DT

In art, we will learn about cross hatching and sketching. In DT, we will design and make a children's toy out of recyclable materials.
