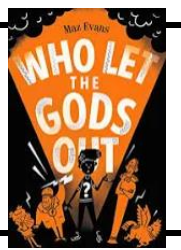

We will also be focusing on exploring emotions and relationships.



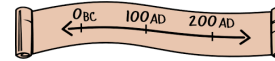
Science
