In school, we take the safety of our pupils seriously. This means on hot days we have a 'Sun Plan'. This means children only have short spells outside. Should we need to put further measure into place we will let you know.

Sports Days

Due to the hot and sunny weather, and the fact that the field has no shade, we have also altered how we are doing sports days this year.

Sports days are now taking place over the whole day and children will be outside for shorter spells. In addition, if the weather is too hot events may be cancelled or completed on different days.
