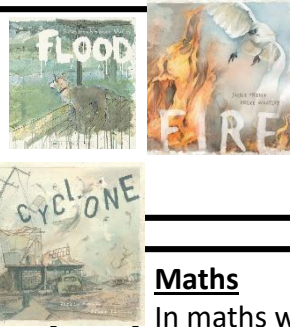

In PSHE we are focusing on 'Being me in my world'. We will set goals, look at our rights and responsibilities and our role in the community and the wider world.



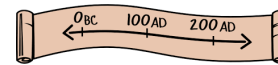
Science

In Science we are focusing on living things. We will learn what is a living thing and classifying living things. We will also look at what a living thing needs to survive.



History

Geography

Music

In music we will start our flutes lessons! We will be learning about rhythm and rhyme

Home Learning
