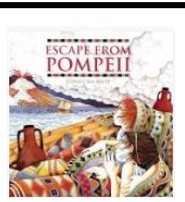

We will write:

Maths

In maths we will:

Add two 6 digit numbers and subtract up to 6 digit numbers.

In PSHE we are focusing on 'Being me in my world'. We will set goals, look at our rights and responsibilities and our role in the community and the wider world.



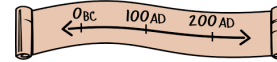
Science

In science we are looking at how materials change state – from solid to liquid to gas. We will also be looking at how some changes are reversible - like the water cycle - and some are irreversible like frying an egg.



History

In history we will learn about the history of the Romans and how they shaped Britain today.



Geography

In geography we will learn about countries surrounding Italy, find the city of Pompeii on a map and locate Mount Vesuvius the volcano which erupted over Pompeii.



Music

In music we will learn about the history of Italian Folk music.



Art/DT

In art we will learn about mosaics and make a pizza as part of DT.



Languages

We will be learning about classroom equipment in French.



Computing

In computing we will learn about safety and look at how to keep safe online.



PE

In PE we will be playing rugby with an emphasis on improved skills and teamwork



RE

We will learn about differences in religions celebrated in school.



Home Learning
