Dear Parents / Carers

Thank you for your patience and understanding this week whilst we put in place clear structures to support pupils' learning during this period of National Lockdown.

Please do continue to follow the Government national guidance to keep yourself and others safe.

I have addressed all the details I believe you need to help you understand the process we will be following over this half term.

We have included information for those children attending school who are considered 'vulnerable' 'new to English' 'SEND' or are children to 'Key Workers' and also information for those that will continue to complete their learning at home.

In School Provision for Critical Workers and Pupils who are classed as 'vulnerable'

- Children will be taught in year group class bubbles of up to 15.
- The school will continue to follow the same risk management procedures from the autumn term
- Pupils will access English, Maths and the Wider Curriculum.
- The school day will begin at **9am** and finish at **3pm**.
- To stagger parents and children arriving on site we will have a 10 minute arrival and 10 minute departure time
 - **Arrival 8.55-9.10am**
 - **Collection 2.55 – 3.05pm**
- Only 1 adult should come to site to drop off or collect and we would ask they wear a face covering
- Please leave the site as quickly as you can once you child is in the school line.

If you are a critical worker or believe your child should be classed as vulnerable then please contact the school office to discuss your child's placement

In School Provision for pupils who are New to English or have a Special Educational Needs

During this period of restricted attendance we are offering sessions to pupils who are New to English or have a Special Educational need.

These are provided **3 mornings a week** and Mrs Struthers and Mrs Dosanjh have been in touch with parents of identified pupils.

This will allow a handful of pupils to access some support in school and support parents in the delivery of home learning. In addition it will support the Governments plans to restrict movement and the number of contacts.

If you think your child has a special educational need or is new to English please contact the school office to discuss your child's placement.

Remote / Home Learning

We will provide **4 hours** of learning every day. There is an expectation that all pupils not in school will complete their learning at home. If your child does not complete learning at home, they may be classed as 'vulnerable' and be expected to come to school to complete their learning.

Daily work can be accessed and completed using these digital learning platforms. Your child will have a username and password to access these activities. They need to upload evidence of their learning so that their teachers can respond.

You will receive updates, links to work and reminders through MarvellousMe. Please make sure you are signed up and receiving messages

Your child has access to these brilliant online resources to help them with key learning. These are ideal places to practice key skills.

Weekly Learning Booklets

If your child is struggling to access learning online, they can collect a booklet of weekly activities from school on the year group feedback day. There will also be an opportunity to collect any useful resources at this time.

Feedback Days and Paper Copies

To support those pupils who are home learning that do not have access to a device we will be providing weekly packs of work.

Pupils who are not able to complete work on Showbie (see remote learning section) are requested to come in and collect work. During collection, you and your child will be able to share and get feedback on their learning from a member of teaching staff.

These sessions will take place weekly on a specified day (see below). Parents and pupils can arrive between 9.30am and 2pm on their year group's day

Monday – Year 4

Tuesday - Year 5

Wednesday - Year 6

Thursday – Year 3

These drop-in sessions will take place in the Roma Community Care section of our school which is accessed off Harrington Street.

There is an expectation that **ALL** pupils will complete learning at home. If your child does not complete learning at home, they may be classed as 'vulnerable' and be expected to come to school to complete their learning.

Remote Learning Expectations

- I will be ready, respectful and responsible when learning online.
- I will check my learning tasks on Showbie or MarvellousMe every day.
- I will ask my teacher for support and help on Showbie if I need it.
- I will upload evidence of my learning onto Showbie.
- I will remember to take screen breaks and stretch my legs.
- I will read to an adult every day.
- I will talk to my teachers about my learning.
- I will use the Internet responsibly.
