Homework

Maths and SPAG homework will be given out each Friday on Showbie and will be expected in the following Tuesday. We ask parents / carers to ensure your child has the opportunity to complete their homework and consolidate their learning.

Knowledge Organisers

At Pear Tree we have introduced Knowledge Organisers (KOs) in class and as homework to help children to learn the essential knowledge they need for each topic they study. A Knowledge Organiser sets out in detail what we want children to know by heart by the end of the topic. We expect the majority of children to be able to recall all of the information on the KO by the end of the topic.

Reading

Your child will have a home school learning log and reading book, which will need to be taken home and returned to school **every day**. Your child should read at home every day and an adult will need to sign the learning log to show that your child has read to an adult. Reading diaries will be checked every week.

PE Kits

Your child will need correct PE kit. As the weather gets colder, we will allow children to wear dark jogging bottoms. We will be doing PE every week.

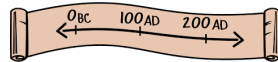
Science

In Science we are focusing on animals including humans, naming and describing the main parts of the human circulatory system (heart, blood vessels and blood). We consider the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on our bodies.



History

In history we will learn about the history of crime and punishment looking at changes over the last century.



Geography

In geography we will learn about America and its cities and landscape.



Shared Reading

Maths

In maths we will:
Improve speed through daily arithmetic practise.

Recognise the order to carry out operations - BEDMAS
