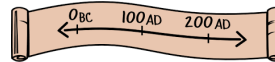

By the end of the unit the children will have a detailed understanding of when the Victorians lived, some of their customs and everyday life. They will know about Victorian transport

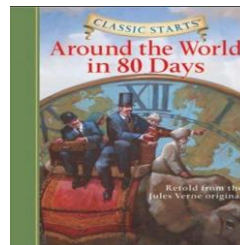


Maths
