PEAR T animals	Mr Sharp's idea for parents to nominate with families	School council thought it was a good idea to have a competition and for there to be prizes.
Anti-bullying	Feedback Anti-BATS	Discipline for children who are bullying - staying in for all of lunchtime, doing extra work. Three warnings and then you have to stay in at lunchtime. Tell a teacher if you see anyone fighting or being horrible to each other. Play with teachers to stay out of trouble. Ban children from playground equipment. Children have to be with teachers if they keep being naughty - go home for dinner. School council thought anti-BATS was a good ideas - suggested getting jackets or vests to wear on top of their coat.
Governors	Talk to governors	Everyone said yes, that's a good idea. NBe to talk to the children closer to the time.
AOB	Tokens When different teachers come in the class don't behave as they should. Dinner hall	Do something special for the winners of the token challenge - class treat, golden time. Children to ask their class for ideas. Certificate for the class. NBe to create. All children agreed that this was the case in their class. We discussed positive reasons to behave. Write down names of children who are behaving and then they get extra playtime. Raffle tickets for good behaviour, dip in the prize box (Atlantis). Feelings box to help children think about their thoughts - year 3 have worry monster. 5 classes with Dojo, all year 3, one year 4 and one year 5. Mr Sharp to come in and see the behaviour.
