

Year 6 Update- Current Provision – The Run In

Here are some of the additional actions that have been undertaken since the start of Spring 2 to achieve better outcomes:

- After school tuition for 18 target children. 3 out of the 4 TA's take 4 children each for an hour after school and cover CGP SATS Busters. 1 TA takes 6 children for a SATS reading booster.
- Afternoon revision groups - we have identified a further 8 children who are on the cusp of achieving ARE and have put in place targeted support in their weaker areas (reasoning) to work with a TA 3 times a week during the afternoon
- Target Readers - Each target child is being listened to read DAILY - one to one for a minimum of 5 minutes with either the teacher or TA in order to develop reading skills.
- Proposals for an Easter Club with 12 target children. These children have been identified based on the latest assessment so that the club is tailored to them. The club will run for three mornings over the Easter holidays.
- Extra time and compensatory marks applications have begun and are currently being processed.
- Timetabling and administration of SATS this year will be different. This is to facilitate readers, extra time, managing distractions and providing greater focus to the children. (See draft proposal TBC)
