

Transition 2019 - Year 6 – Moving up

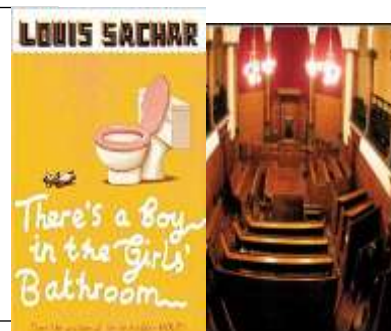

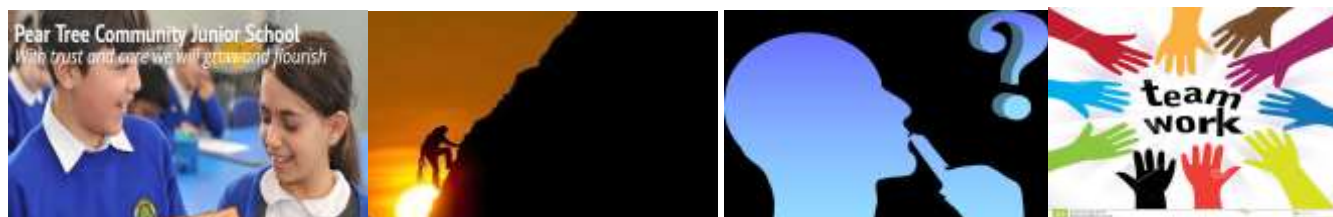
